HOW TO MARTA

A fast and affordable way to navigate the city, MARTA provides approximately 500,000 passenger trips each weekday in Atlanta. Purchase a reloadable Breeze Card (\$2) and add the desired fare amount (\$2.50 per single ride). Breeze tickets also are available for a \$1 surcharge plus the \$2.50 fare for a single ride. Breeze Cards and tickets can be purchased at Breeze vending machines located in rail stations or MARTA Ride Stores. You can also order the MARTA Visitor Pass in advance.

Dome/GWCC/Philips Arena/CNN Center Station serves Georgia World Congress Center, Mercedes-Benz Stadium, Centennial Olympic Park, State Farm Arena and CNN Center.

Peachtree Center Station serves World of Coca-Cola, NationalCenterforCivil&HumanRights,Chick-fil-ACollege Football Hall of Fame, AmericasMart Atlanta, convention hotels, Centennial Olympic Park, Georgia Aquarium and Children's Museum of Atlanta.

Arts Center Station serves Woodruff Arts Center/High Museum of Art, Center for Puppetry Arts, Atlanta Botanical Garden and Atlantic Station.

Buckhead and Lenox Stations serve Buckhead hotels, restaurants, Lenox Square and Phipps Plaza.

MARTA's #110 bus route, "The Peach," connects downtown to Buckhead via Peachtree Street, offering a way to enjoy restaurants, shopping and entertainment along Atlanta's most famous thoroughfare

ATLANTA STREETCAR

The Atlanta Streetcar is Atlanta's newest transportation option. The 2.7 mile loop has 12 stops that connect Centennial Olympic Park with the Martin Luther King, Jr. National Historical Park and nearby neighborhoods east of downtown. With a direct connection to MARTA's Peachtree Center station, and other transit services, the Atlanta Streetcar provides the last mile of connectivity to the city's public transportation system. **TRAIN HOURS** Weekdays: 4:45am-1am Weekends: 6am-1am

Tips for taxi use

If paying by credit card, verify the taxi can accept this form of payment before entering the vehicle. Please note, many Atlanta taxi drivers are independent operators and do not have the ability to accept credit cards

It IS permissible to hail a cab from the curb/street.

Understanding Zone Fare vs Metered Fare- Atlanta is unique from most cities, in that the most heavily trafficked areas are set on flat rate zone fares. This is why many times you will not see the driver start the meter. However, when traveling to a point outside of the zone, the driver will start the meter at the point of exiting the zone boundary, and the fare will be a total of the zone fare plus the additional metered distance to the destination.

RENTAL CARS

Hartsfield-Jackson Atlanta International Airport

If you choose to rent a car in Atlanta, our rental car center makes it easy once you've arrived at Hartsfield-Jackson Atlanta International Airport. The ATL SkyTrain is an elevated train that connects the passenger terminal to the rental car center, and takes customers on a scenic, fiveminute ride to the rental car center to sign rental agency contracts and pick up cars. The ATL SkyTrain operates six two-car trains, with each car accommodating up to 50 passengers and their baggage.

The rental car center is a 67.5-acre site across from the airport and houses all airport rental car companies and their associated operations, including customer service, administrative offices, car pickup and return, fueling and maintenance facilities.

UBER/LYFT

Uber and Lyft connect riders in Atlanta with drivers via their mobile apps, which you can download for free today.

For Atlanta Airport: all rideshare drivers will pick up passengers at the North and South economy lots, which are a short walk from baggage claim. Passengers will proceed through baggage claim toward the Georgia Lottery booth for access to the lower-level escalators. Once downstairs, follow the orange signs to the Economy lot and request a ride only after arrival at the pick-up location.

OTHER WAYS TO GET AROUND ATLANTA

Atlanta is accessible via Interstates 20, 75, and 85 and Georgia 400. I-285 forms a beltway around the city.

The Buckhead Uptown Connection (The Buc) provides free service throughout the Buckhead business district. Stops include the Lenox and Buckhead MARTA stations, Lenox Square and Phipps Plaza, various restaurants and hotels and numerous office buildings.

Last-Mile Mobility options such as Relay Bike and scooters (such as BIRD, Lime and Uber) are located in various areas of the city. Simply download an app, locate the transportation mode and unlock it from the app.

AMTRAK offers service to New Orleans, New York and points in between.

Atlanta is the Southern hub for megabus.com.
